COMMITTEE REPORTS

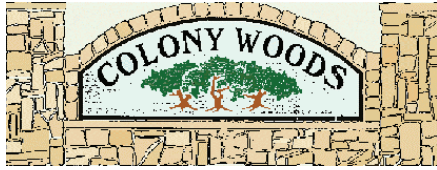
