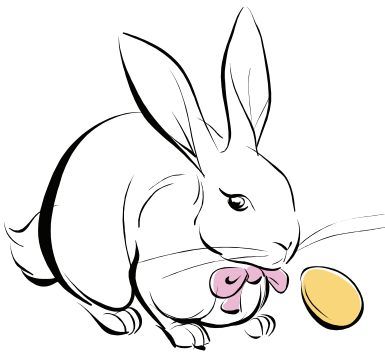

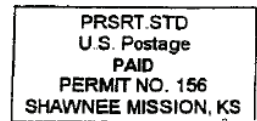
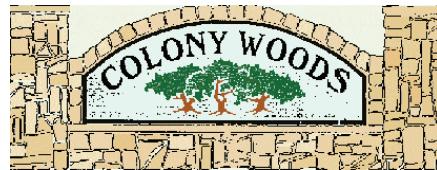

CW Vice-President, Tony Corporon, called the CW Board meeting to order on February 11, 2008 at approximately 7:10 p.m. Board and Committee members present were T. Corporon, G. Quackenbush, J. Williams, and M. Ewing. A motion was made and seconded to approve the January 2008 minutes as written. Motion approved.

Quackenbush also reported that 151 homes have voted in favor of the proposed Amendment to the Colony Woods Homes Association Declaration; 59 have voted in opposition of the Amendment; and 62 homes have not yet submitted a ballot. Ballots are available from G. Quackenbush and will be sent out with the dues reminder notices. Ballots will also be available at the Annual Meeting on March 10, 2008.
